



Attention All Ganaraska Forest Users

- ✓ All forest roads and trails are closed to motorized use (with exception of snowmobiles) from December 1st to May 1st.
- ✓ All forest roads and trails are closed to non-motorized use from March 1st to May 1st, with exception of hiking and cross-country skiing.
- ✓ Closure dates are subject to change by Conservation staff based on weather and trail conditions. Information on changes is available by calling the Ganaraska Forest Centre at 905.797.2721, or by checking the Ganaraska Region Conservation Authority website at www.grca.on.ca or www.ganaraskaforestcentre.ca.
- ✓ Ganaraska Forest users have access to a public washroom facility that includes both men's and women's stalls, as well as showers. The washrooms are located north of the gymnasium and Trail Head Centre.
- ✓ Ganaraska Forest users have weekend access to the canteen located in the Ganaraska Forest Trail Head Centre.
- ✓ Please be advised that the Ganaraska Region Conservation Authority has a new regulation in place regarding the use of off-road vehicles in the Ganaraska Forest. The regulation states that all off-road vehicles are required to have spark arrestors and that no off-road vehicle exhaust system shall be modified in such a manner that would result in increased noise emissions. An existing regulation is in place requiring that off-road vehicles not exceed 94 decibels.
