



NOTICE TO ALL GANARASKA FOREST USERS

The Ganaraska Forest Centre (GFC), located in the central section of the Ganaraska Forest, is visited by close to 8,000 students each year and thousands of other guests of all ages who come to experience the great outdoors and gain education about environmental conservation. The redeveloped multi-use facility accommodates outdoor education programs, community and corporate group rentals and special events, along with being home of the Oak Ridges Moraine Information Centre.

Please take note:

- ✓ Riders of off-road vehicles (ATVs and off-road motorcycles) will not be allowed to ride anywhere on Forest Centre grounds. They will be required to park in a designated parking area located in the northwest corner of the property. From this area they can easily walk to any of the GFC facilities. Access to the parking area is provided by a trail coming off of the unmaintained section of Cold Springs Camp Road, just north of the main driveway into the GFC. The motorized trail that wraps around the perimeter of the GFC will remain open to motorized use.
- ✓ Snowmobile riders will be required to park their machines in the designated parking area mentioned above.
- ✓ The newly expanded horse trailer parking lot should be used for parking and unloading horse trailers and provides direct access to the Central Forest. A horse paddock is located at the northeast corner of the Forest Centre property and provides a place for riders to secure their horses while making use of Forest Centre facilities.
- ✓ Forest users towing ORVs, snowmobiles or horse trailers will be permitted to drive into the Forest Centre and can park on a short term basis in one of the parking areas while making use of GFC facilities.
