

What can I do in the Central section of the Ganaraska Forest?

What do I need to use the Ganaraska Forest?

All users require a day pass or an annual forest membership. You will receive a parking permit with your day pass or membership which must be displayed on all vehicles parked in the forest.

Where can I get detailed forest maps?

All locations that sell day passes and memberships also carry detailed coloured maps of all three forest areas – west, central and east. Maps are \$5.00 for non-members and \$3.00 for Ganaraska Forest members.

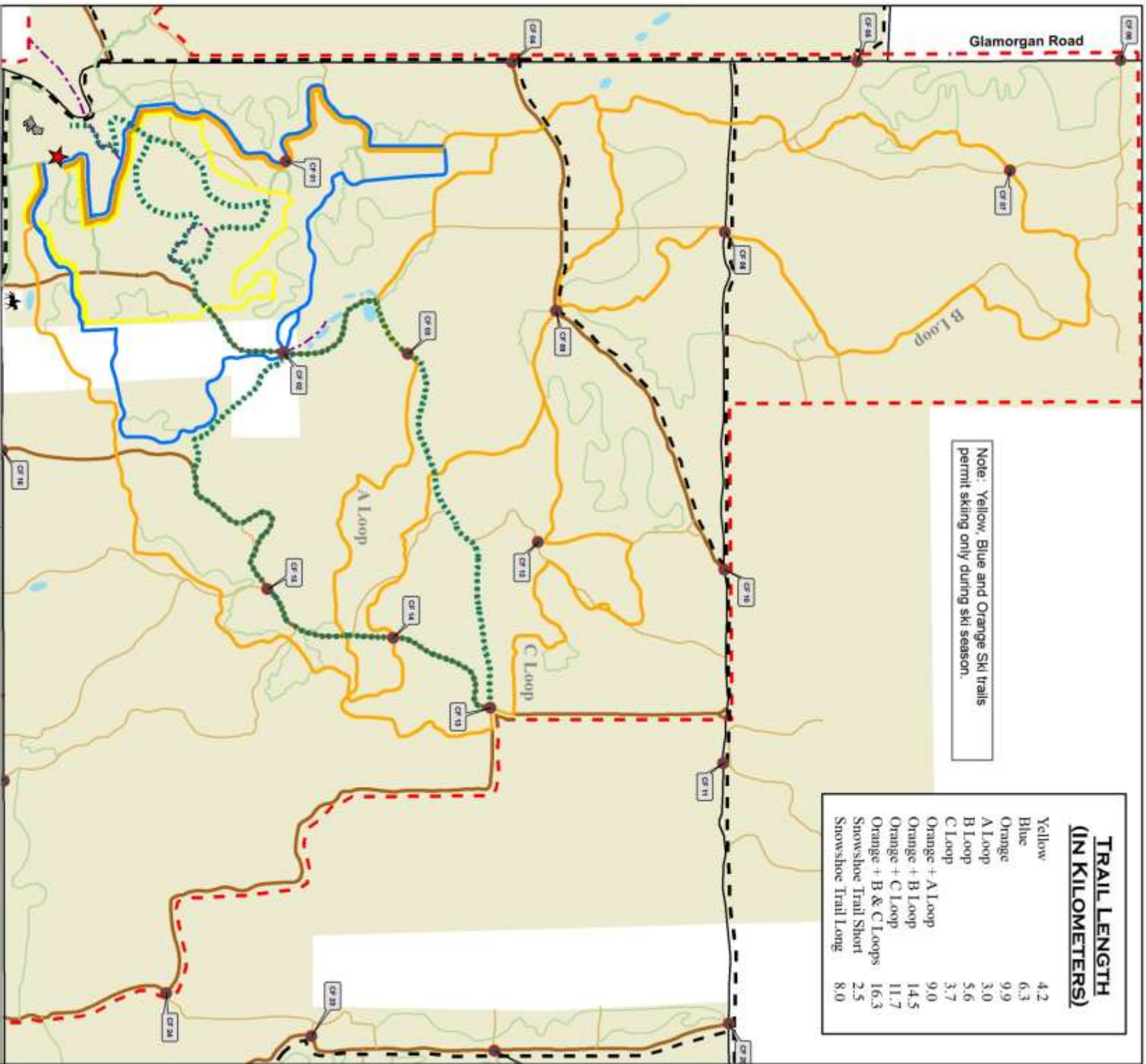

EXPLORE THE GANARASKA FOREST



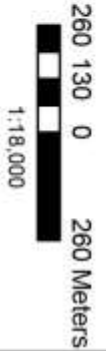


Note: Yellow, Blue and Orange Ski trails permit skiing only during ski season.
